

The book compares our knowledge of the world through science versus through myths. The book discusses a variety of creation myths and doesn't just look at the western world. The authors also discuss the development of new technologies and how religious/conservative forces frequently reject these technologies. The book is philosophically similar to The Bible Is Not Great: The Truth About The Bible, Religion And God by Soren Sagan But the the Singh/Shook effort is much better written and the science is more accurate and detailed.
