


I've been using LINQ for about a year (mostly LINQ-to-objects and LINQ-to-Xml) but recently started a new project using extensive LINQ-to-SQL. The book begins by laying a solid, easy to understand foundation, explaining the core concepts in just the right amount of detail, before building-up to more complicated topics. Reading this book helped me finally understand LINQ in ways that I could only guess-at before (like, what really is the difference between IEnumerable and IQueryable). Aside from one or two very minor errors, this is probably one of the best technical books I've read in a long time and I would recommend it for anyone wanting to truly understand LINQ inside-&-out.
